BOARD MEETING MINUTES: MAY 5, 2013

May board Meeting- held on May 5th @ 7:30 at Sharon's house.

Some of us brought carnelian and quartz that was found at the dig in Kalama the previous day so we started the board meeting with some show and tell. We talked a little about the Mystic Blaster spot cleaner that was used to clean some of the finds and noted that cleaning crystals would be a good topic for an upcoming meeting.

Martin went over the previous main meeting in April since Kim had missed it and we realized that we still need to vote in a new Secretary. Kim is going to check into how much two 40lb barrels are thru Lortone, since the club voted on buying this for Norma and Kevin who do the polishing for the club.

We discussed the next meeting in May, we have a demonstrator scheduled to come in and show how to knap arrowheads and such. We have a backup plan of a video if he does not make it. We need to have some slabs of obsidian cut $\frac{1}{4}$ " – $\frac{1}{2}$ " thick for the knapper to use in his demonstration. I guess there are 9-stages of knapping this will be an interesting meeting.

Maureen will be teaching the kids about Stone Age tools, which ties in nicely with the adult meeting.

We plan on having a pot luck summer party if everyone votes on it and if we can arrange it at Kevin's to sort rocks for the show next year. We also plan on having a summer rock cutting party/potluck at Norma's house on September 8th, 10:00-4:00, no early birds.

The club has submitted the ads for the Mineral Federation on our show next year. Our address has been changed to our club P.O. box as the show promoter had an old address for the club.

The library in Kirkland would love volunteers for someone to teach classes at the library – this would be a nice way for the club to give back to the community. We will see if we have any takers on this task. We still need to get the club key from Evan, and another key made.

We need to remind everyone that in July and August we have no club meetings. We are all set up for Meet up.com and Robin will keep it updated for now until we get someone else. The bylaws still need to be edited and we need to see if we
